
PROVOST FOR RESEARCH AND DEAN OF THE GRADUATE DIVISION JOSEPH CERNY:

Delegation of Authority--Execution of Purchase Contracts, Sub-  
contracts, and Standard Purchase Orders for Goods and Services  
to be Supplied to the University

Subsequent to the delegation of authority To Solicit and Accept or Execute Certain Extramural Grants and Contracts re-delegated to you August 2, 1988, I am re-delegating to you, in your position as, Provost for Research and Dean of the Graduate Division, the authority to issue and execute subgrants and subcontracts in amounts not to exceed \$2,000,000 in total funding, to non-profit and not-for-profit collaborating organizations under campus prime grants and contracts.

This re-delegation is made in accordance with the referenced authority to execute purchase contracts, subcontracts, and standard purchase orders for goods and services to be supplied to the University as an exception granted by Senior Vice President Brady in his letter to me of April 10, 1986.
