RE: Delegation of Authority 2195 – *To Write Off Disallowed Sponsored Project Charges*

In accordance with President Dynes' letter of January 7, 2008 to the Chancellors, I am redelegating to the Vice Chancellor for Research, the authority to fund disallowed claims of any amount that arise from performance of sponsored projects. Costs charged to sponsored funds that will not be collected from the sponsor or that which must be refunded for reasons of unallowability, unallocability, a dispute with the sponsor, or other reasons, must be paid from University unrestricted funds. Funds received from the federal government in reimbursement of indirect costs are University unrestricted funds and may be used to fund such disallowed claims.

This delegation of authority may be redelegated to the appropriate administrator within your jurisdiction.

Delegation of Authority--To Write Off Disallowed Sponsored Project Charges

Section 100.4 of the Standing Orders of The Regents, Duties of the President of the University, provides as follows:

- (x) The President is authorized to write off against funds received from the Federal Government in reimbursement of indirect costs, routine disallowed claims under grants and contracts.

Effective immediately, you are delegated authority to fund disallowed claims of any amount that arise from performance of sponsored projects. Costs charged to sponsored funds that will not be collected from the sponsor or that which must be refunded for reasons of unallowability, unallocability, a dispute with the sponsor, or other reasons, must be paid from University unrestricted funds. Funds received from the federal government in reimbursement of indirect costs are University unrestricted funds and may be used to fund such disallowed claims.

Any re-delegation of the foregoing authority shall be in writing with copies to the General Counsel of the Regents, the Vice President—Finance, and the Universitywide Policy Office.

This supersedes the letter to Chancellors dated September 19, 1977 (DA 0582) and that to the Vice President—Financial and Business Management dated December 1, 1982 (DA 0757).
