

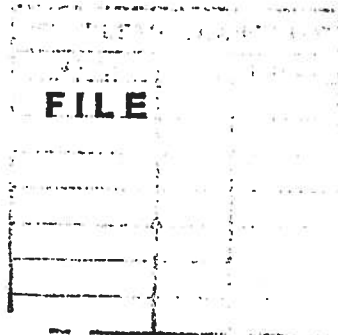

Dear Mr. Fassell:

This letter provides an update to our May 11, 2004 and September 17, 2007 letters of intent.

As Chancellor of the University of California, Berkeley, I exercise express authority and responsibility to approve funds for decommissioning activities associated with operations authorized by the Radiologic Health Branch of the Department of Public Health, Radioactive Materials License Number 1333-01.

This authority is established by the Standing Orders of the Regents of the University of California governing administrative and budgetary authority of the individual campuses. Within this authority I intend to make funding available when necessary in the amount of \$5 million to decommission the University of California, Berkeley. I intend to request and obtain funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.

A copy of Standing Order 100.6 is attached as evidence that I am authorized to represent the University of California, Berkeley in this transaction.
